MAKE YOUR CAR SAFER

Every week, 50 children in the United States are backed over by cars—and not just SUVs, according to the consumer group Kids and Cars. All autos have a blind zone in the back, which is why safety experts recommend using a back-up camera. Audiovox's new ACA250 Do-It-Yourself Wireless Color Monitor and Back-Up Camera System (\$130; *mobile.audiovox.com*) is a great option because you can install it yourself. The camera has a 110-degree viewing angle and an infrared LED light for use at night. It attaches to your license plate and wirelessly communicates with a 2.5-inch monitor that you affix to your dashboard and plug into the power adapter.
